### ORGANIZATIONS FOR KIDS EVENTS

- Organizations must provide at least one pre-approved kid friendly activity or game at all times booth is in operation
- Only organizations that have a Village of Wilmette business license or are a business that is registered and in "Good Standing" with the State of Illinois

### EVENT DETAILS AND REQUIREMENTS

- Cost: \$100.00 per booth which includes one 9x18 foot parking space, one table and two chairs
  - Payment may be made in person by cash or credit card or check made out to The Village of Wilmette
- Organizations may bring additional tables or tents, as long as the items stay contained within the designated area
- Organizations may only bring other materials not listed above if previously approved by the Village of Wilmette
- Each organization is responsible for their own set up and removal of items. Organizations are only allowed to setup on Saturday, September 10 between 8 - 10:45 am and all items must be removed by 6 pm
- Sales of any kind are not permitted
- The Village of Wilmette has the right to remove any items it deems inappropriate
- Booths must have at least one person who is 18 or older present at the table throughout the entire event

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- All organizations and activities shall comply with all laws at all times
- Booths are subject to inspection by the Village of Wilmette to ensure compliance with Village Codes
- Village of Wilmette is not responsible for any loss or damage suffered by an organization
- Booth location shall be determined by the Village of Wilmette in its sole discretion
